Thank you for your recent application requesting the re-registration of the above captioned organization as a Charitable Organization.

We are pleased to inform you that the Charity Commissioners have approved your application, and have authorized that the re-registration of the organization shall be for the period of **ONE YEAR ONLY**. You are therefore further informed that the registration was affected under the above instructions on the 13<sup>th</sup> August 2008 and will terminate on the 13<sup>th</sup> August 2009. **The organization's registration number shall remain at #812.**

Enclosed is an "Aide Memoire", a copy of the relevant section of the Act and a copy of the Regulations. Please read these carefully as they will assist your executive committee in fulfilling some of its most important obligations. It is of extreme importance that the executive committee notes that an "Income and Expenditure Statement" (**in duplicate with two signatures on both**) must be forwarded to this office within six months after the end of the organization's fiscal year. It should also be noted that whenever there are changes in the names of the officers, the Registrar General should be informed within **thirty days** of such changes. A form is enclosed that may be copied and used for this


purpose. In both cases, The Registry General will be responsible for submitting the reports to the Charity Commissioners.

The members of the organization's executive should familiarize themselves with the requirements of the Charities Act, 1978. One may be obtained from the Department of Information Services, Global House, Church Street Hamilton at a nominal fee, or one may be perused and/or copied at the Public Library in Hamilton.

If changes to the list of officers, fund raising activities or to the constitution of the organization have been made they should be stated in an "Application for Re-registration" form. In either case, an up-to-date financial statement must accompany the application for re-registration.
